ORDER

(Alteration of days appointed to be public holidays)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 6 of the Public Holidays Ordinance (Cap. 81), I hereby declare the following days to be public holidays for 2026.

Wednesday, 15 th July	Kiribati Special Day
Monday, 3 rd August	National Youth & Children's Day
Monday, 5 th October	World Teachers Day
Friday 11 th December	In honour of Human Rights Day

Monday, 28 th December	In honour of Boxing Day (Gift Day)

Thursday 31 st December	Kiribati Holiday


I further declare that any day appointed to be a public holiday under section 2 of the Ordinance that does not appear in the list above shall be a public holiday in 2026.

The order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st of January 2026 and any Order previously made for the same purpose shall be null and void.
